High School BCSIP

Goal 1: Improve recognition of students for academic achievement. Goal 2: Expand Alternative Education programming. Goal 3: Improve HS MAP Test Scores in IEP Population. The strategies are to be in place by August of next year. The counselors are currently talking with the Middle School counselors to coordinate a Freshman Transition Program. A motion was made and passed to accept the BCSIP plan as presented.

IV. Book Study: Several members mentioned things that were meaningful to them. One comment was how the chapter required the reader to look at personal commitment and realize that it takes courage to be willing to change and try new things. The chapter mentioned several routes to failure and how to avoid each one.
