Block # 1 - Lesson # 9

Concept: Webbed Writing

Learning Style	<div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around; align-items: center;"> Auditory Visual Tactile </div> <p style="text-align: center;">The learning style addressed by the activity will be in bold-faced letters.</p>
Rationale	Students begin to “write” in their brains in a developed manner.
Activity	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Have five volunteers come to the front of the room. 2) Give them a topic. (I.e. “I got the coolest gift from my aunt on her last visit.”) 3) Ask them to stand in a circle and pass the yarn (to make a star) while they are creating webbed sentences on their own. (You will need to listen and gently guide the students so that they, indeed, verbalize webbed sentences -each sentence refers to the sentence directly before it. Do not let them list, this will confuse the students in the classroom.) 4) Repeat this in front of the class with different volunteers, until every student has had a chance to web.
